E530204	'The History of the Church of Scotland from the First tyne of Planting of the Christian faith in this kingdome, Divided into seven booke . . . Collected by the Right Reverend father in God John [Spottiswoode] Archbishop of St Andrewes and Primate of the Kingdome of Scotland.' 17th cent. (1st half). Formerly owned by Kelso Public library. Bore the name 'hautherdail' on fly-leaf and hence believed to have been owned at one time by the Earl of Lauderdale. It does not seem, however, to have been one of the two MSS. of Spottiswoode's history commonly known to have been in the Lauderdale library. A copy of the printed edition ^{of 1677} in E.V.L., La. III. 780, has ^{MS.} marginal additions etc. from these MSS. and on p. 267 is a reference to a section as missing in dubious MSS. Lauderdaleianis, which nevertheless is in this MS. f. 140 ^v , ll. 6-18. But cf. La. III. 780, p. 168 where the MS. addition to l. 24 is in this MS. f. 80, ll. 40-41.
